#### **Abstract**

This poster presents the archaeological settlement pattern of the Uruk period which result of the actual survey in the region between Fara and Isin, Iraq (KALAM project 2023-24). Numerous large, medium-sized and small Uruk sites with an amazing richness of archaeological material have been discovered. After rain, the mapping of the settlement structures proved very successful. At the same time, the traditions in ceramic production and the distribution patterns of certain object groups will be analysed, discussed and illustrated in their interregional context.
